# 2013 CABERNET SAUVIGNON **BARREL SELECTION**

<b>LOCATION</b>	Mosquito Creek, Joanna
<b>ALC/VOL</b>	14.5%
<b>VARIETY</b>	100% Cabernet Sauvignon
<b>OAK</b>	Aged for over 2 years in seasoned and new French Oak barrels
<b>RELEASED</b>	August 2015



We have produced high quality Cabernets for nearly 30 years, (the last 10 years from Mosquito Creek vineyard), at Joanna, Wratttonbully Region, in the South East of South Australia.

From the excellent 2013 vintage, following the outstanding 2012 season, we have again selected the very best barrels to produce a Cabernet to equal the previous multi-award winning Cabernets over a long period.

The hand-picked grapes from a low yielding crop on the classic 'terra rossa over limestone soil', was aged for 2 years in new and aged French Oak barrels.

A wine that will develop significantly in the bottle with careful cellaring, maturing into a full bodied wine, dark in colour with complex and intense berry fruit flavours with fine, well balanced tannins and an elegant finish.
