CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2001

We believe this wine to be a worthy successor to our 2000 'Barrel Selection' Cabernet. Unusually for any wine these days, this wine spent nearly three years in 1-3 year old French oak.

This gradual maturing process in oak has been carefully monitored to produce a wine that is not dominated by oak, but has resulted in a smooth, very well balanced wine with soft tannins. It has flavours typical of our previous Cabernets from the vineyard with the classic terra-rossa over limestone soil.

Ripe grapes were picked in a low-yielding vintage, (1.0 to 1.5 tonnes per acre), fermented at cool temperatures and with minimum filtration to ensure maximum fruit flavours.

A classic, elegant Cabernet from a region famous for its Cabernets'. This wine has continued to develop significantly with bottle age and we have done much of the cellaring for you!

Drink now to 2015 – at least.
