CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2002

Region Wrattenbully, South Australia

Vineyard/Location Koppamurra, Joanna

Alc/Vol 15.5%

Grape Variety 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Oak Aged for 36 months in new and aged French Oak

'This superb cabernet... with great intensity and complexity on both nose and palate. The tannins are marvellously fine and the oak is perfectly handled. The wine will thrive on extended cellaring, and although its high in alcohol, it's neither hot or heavy.'

'EXCELLENT VALUE – GOLD & TROPHY'

A classic, elegant Cabernet in the tradition of our high quality cabernets from our original vineyard at Joanna, on the famous wine-making soil: terra-rossa-over-limestone.

Ripe grapes, a low yielding vintage (1.5 to 2.0 tonnes/acre), a cool ferment, and minimum filtration to ensure full fruit flavours.

We patiently allowed this wine to develop slowly for 3 years in aged French Oak, carefully monitoring the process to produce a well balanced wine with soft tannins.

Early tastings indicated a wine with already well developed 'aged' characteristics suitable for immediate drinking. With bottle age the wine has developed into a truly high class cabernet, which will continue to develop further with patient cellaring.

Drink now to 2012 – at least, probably more.
