CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2006

Region Wrattenbully, South Australia

Vineyard/Location Mosquito Creek, Joanna

Alc/Vol 15%

Grape Variety 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Oak Aged over 20 months in new and aged French Oak

Winestate September/October 2008

21 tasted, 11 recommended – Koppamurra 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon.

'Lovely fresh, lifted cabernet with violets on the nose and blackberries on the palate, and all cloaked in oak'.

The first Cabernet from our source vineyard at Joanna (in the south east of South Australia). The same vineyard as our Gold awarded 2005 Shiraz.

Ripe grapes, from a very low yielding vintage, (1.5 to 2 tonnes/acre) grown on the famous terra-rossa-over-limestone soil.

When quite new, our initial tastings indicated a wine that was quite approachable early on, but one that will also develop significantly with bottle age over the coming years.

Developing all the characteristics typical of the region's cabernets, with intense fruit flavours and well balanced tannins.

With proper cellaring will continue to improve and develop.

Drink to 2017 – at least.
