Another very impressive wine from a past trophy winner, and one of the most consistent entrants of quality reds. This wine is beautifully aromatic, spicy and peppery. The palate is long, fine, elegant and balanced.

The 2005 Shiraz was the first red wine from our new source vineyard at Joanna, (in the south east part of South Australia) – on the famous terra-rossa-over-limestone soil.

Some black pepper and slightly 'earthy' characters typical of the region, are already evident, as are ample complex berry flavours – see above for the critics opinion.

Ripe grapes, from a low yielding vintage (2.0 tonnes/acre); over 12 months in both new and aged French Oak.

With proper cellaring will continue to improve and develop.
